

## Leaf Charm

## Clay is easy to be textured, because of its softness ! Try with your favourite leaf



For proper use, please read the instruction sheet of Art Clay and Stainless steel net for gas stove.



## Materials and tools

- $\bigcirc$  Art Clay Silver 5g~7g  $\bigcirc$  Your favourite Leaf  $\bigcirc$  Baking sheet
- $\bigcirc$  Water  $\bigcirc$  Straw (Narrow type)  $\bigcirc$  Hair dryer  $\bigcirc$  Tweezer
- $\odot$  Sponge sanding pad (red)  $\bigcirc$  Pencil  $\bigcirc$  Needle  $\bigcirc$  Stainless steel brush
- $\bigcirc$  Chain or rope  $\bigcirc$  Stainless steel net for gas stove



Roll Art Clay Clay type flat, whose size is enough to fit your leaf. \*Roll it on baking sheet.



Place a leaf on the clay. The side has clear vein should touch the clay. \*\*Moisten clay time to time to avoid clay from drying up.



Puch the leaf softly on the clay to transfer. \*/If you would like to make the surface flat, you could push with a ruler.



Make a hole with a straw and dry it for 15mins. This hole is used to through a finding for chain.



After the clay dried, take the leaf out with a tweezer. Or you can leave the leaf as it is.



Smooth the surface with a sponge sanding pad. (Red)



Adding message or initial, you write a draft with pencil and engrave with something sharp such as needle. \*\*Try not to use much tension, it break or causing crack of clay.



Fire with gas stove for 5 mins.

After firing, polish it with a stainless steel brush.



Attach your favourite finding or chain.
